## CAMP COACHES



### JOHN BARNES

Head Coach | @CoachJohnBarnes

In his four years as Youngstown State's head coach, John Barnes has continued to increase the program's standards both on and off the court. The Penguins earned an at-large berth to play in the Women's NIT in 2014-15, and they advanced to the semifinals of the Women's Basketball Invitational postseason tournament in 2015-16. YSU has led the Horizon League in 3-pointers per game in each of the past three seasons and had a post player earn all-league honors in each of his

four seasons. At the same time, YSU had the third-best GPA in the country in 2015-16 at 3.639.

Barnes came to YSU as a winner across all levels. He spent the 2012-13 season as the associate head coach at Horizon League Champion Green Bay, and he's also been an assistant coach in the Big Ten at Wisconsin and Michigan. As a head coach, he led Division II Michigan Tech to 156 wins and five appearances in the NCAA Tournament from 2003-10.

**Location:** Stambaugh Stadium Gyms  
**Cost:** \$115 if registering by June 5; \$125 after June 5. Walkups will be accepted.

The focus of this camp is to improve the all-around game. Participants will work on all fundamentals with ball handling, passing, shooting, defense and rebounding drills. There will also be individual and team competitions where awards will be given. Campers will be separated into groups based on age and skill level. There will be a maximum of 10 campers per instructor. Prizes and a t-shirt are included.
