In his four years as Youngstown State's head coach, John Barnes has continued to increase the program's standards both on and off the court. The Penguins earned an at-large berth to play in the Women's NIT in 2014-15, and they advanced to the semifinals of the Women's Basketball Invitational postseason tournament in 2015-16. YSU has led the Horizon League in 3-pointers per game in each of the past three seasons and had a post player earn all-league honors in each of his

four seasons. At the same time, YSU had the third-best GPA in the country in 2015-16 at 3.639.

Barnes came to YSU as a winner across all levels. He spent the 2012-13 season as the associate head coach at Horizon League Champion Green Bay, and he's also been an assistant coach in the Big Ten at Wisconsin and Michigan. As a head coach, he led Division II Michigan Tech to 156 wins and five appearances in the NCAA Tournament from 2003-10.
